NAME

chdir — change working directory

SYNOPSIS

chdir = 12.

ARGUMENTS(input)

capability associated with working directory of sender process
0 - name byte offset into message
1 - pathname of file

VALUES(returned)

0 - new working directory capability number

DESCRIPTION

Chdir causes the directory specified by the given pathname to become the new working directory. The capability of the old directory is deleted from the sender's PCB and the capability of the new directory is added to the sender's PCB.

DIAGNOSTICS

An error status byte is returned if the given name is not that of a working directory or it is not readable.
