## UMOUNT (VIII)

### NAME

umount – dismount file system

### SYNOPSIS

**/etc/umount** special

### DESCRIPTION

*Umount* announces to the system that the removable file system previously mounted on special file *special* is to be removed. Only the super-user may unmount file systems.

### DIAGNOSTICS

Frequently, in the case of */usr*, the file system is found to be busy because one of the Shell accounting files (*/usr/admlsh\_acct* or */usr/admlsu\_acct*) is open for some Shell or system accounting is active (*/usr/admlacct*).
